

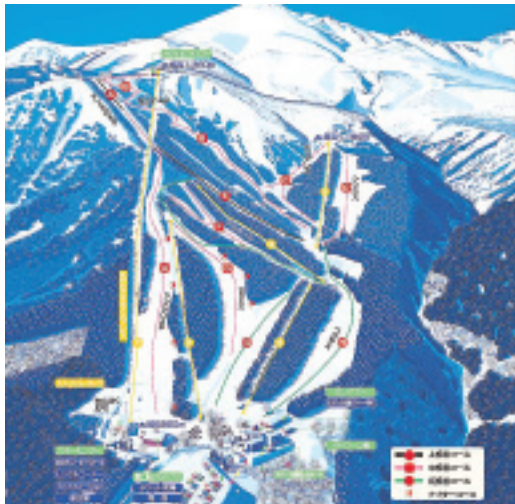

Scheduled opening
Early Dec.



Go straight up to the summit on the high-speed "Adatarara Express" gondola. A wide variation of powder snow courses pleases beginners and experts alike whether skiers or snowboarders. An exciting 2,100-meter downhill enhanced by the incomparable view of the Adatarara Range.

ACCESS Shuttle bus
Approx. 30 min. drive from Nihonmatsu Sta. on the JR Tohoku-honsen Line; approx. 20 min. after exiting Nihonmatsu I.C. on Tohoku Expressway
* Come empty-handed using "Bus Pack" (round-trip bus fare + 1 day lift ticket + equipment & wear rental; daily from late Dec. to early Apr.; ¥5,000 for adult, ¥4,000 for child, ¥500 more on Sat., Sun. & year end/New Year season; outward trip lv. Koriyama Sta. 9:00, return trip lv. ski area 17:00 bound for Koriyama Sta.)

COURSE GUIDE

- A) Andromeda: The main course accommodates intermediate and advanced skiers. Run is 1,800-meter long with max. gradient of 33° (average 18°).
B) Cassiopeia: Intermediate terrain commanding a superb view. Run is 1,400-meter long with max. gradient of 20° (average 13°).
C) Hercules: Intermediate terrain offering virgin snow. Run is 700-meter long with max. gradient of 23° (average 17°).
D) Sirius: Intermediate terrain, spacious and an easy glide. Run is 600-meter long with max. gradient of 28° (average 18°).
E) Vega: Advanced terrain with a sharp incline from the halfway point. Run is 700-meter long with max. gradient of 28° (average 20°).
F) Altair: Beginner to intermediate terrain, the upper section is a mogul slope and the lower section a forest course. Run is 600-meter long with max. gradient of 28° (average 18°).
G) Gemini: Beginner to intermediate terrain, spacious and an easy glide, which is highly popular. Run is 800-meter long with max. gradient of 20° (average 15°).
H) Pegasus: Beginner terrain with moderate incline, suitable for lessons. Run is 450-meter long with max. gradient of 15° (average 10°).

- * Season: Early Dec. ~ early Apr.
- * Ski slopes: 8 in total
- * Artificial snow machines: Several units
- * Ski lifts: 4 lifts, 1 gondola
- * Lift hours: 8:30 ~ 18:00 on weekdays and during Mar. 21 ~ Apr. 4 period; till 16:30 during Dec. 6 ~ 21; 7:00 ~ 18:00 on Sat., Sun. and year end/New Year season
- * Parking lot capacity: 1,500 cars (free of charge)
- * Snowboarding: All slopes

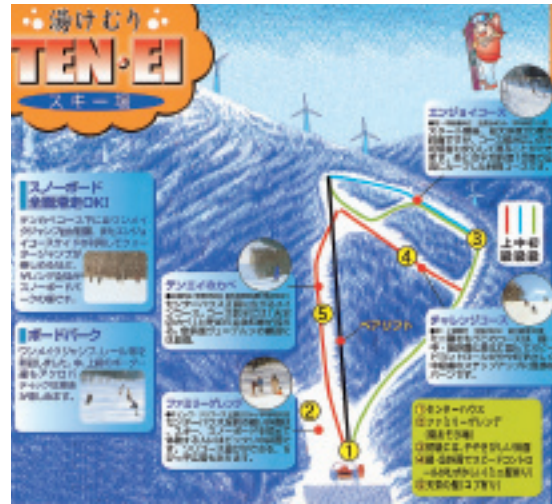

Though strong wind may blow outside, here you can ski the slopes under totally windless conditions! With a pair lift and four courses, this area caters to families and experts alike. Our restaurant pleases guests with its menu of homemade dishes. The highly recommended are "katsu-don" (rice topped with port cutlet cooked in egg) and soup noodles (soba) topped with mixed tempura. Within a 5 to 15 min. walk are several onsen (hot spring) inns where you can immerse in a hot spring bath after an exhilarating ski day.

COURSE GUIDE

- ◎ Tenkabe Course: Max. gradient is 38 degrees. Natural non-groomed powder snow can be enjoyed. Also recommended for snowboarders.
- ◎ Challenge Course: Natural non-groomed powder snow can be enjoyed. Ideal as a practice course for upgrading your skill.
- ◎ Enjoy Course: This forest course, with average gradient of 10 degrees, is beginner-friendly.
- ◎ Family Slope: Ideal for sledding and other on-snow leisure activities.

- * Ski slopes: 4 in total

COURSE GUIDE

A total of 11 courses, laid out on the foothills of 1,510-meter-high Mt. Kamafusa, guarantee the highest-quality snow. Each is wide and boasts a long run that ensures dynamic gliding. The upper section contains an inviting virgin forest course of moderate incline that guarantees family fun. The Family Course in front of Center Dome is highly recommended for children. The #5 quad lift has been upgraded to a high-speed lift, a first in Fukushima Prefecture. Getting off the lift, you can enjoy a 2-kilometer exhilarating run.

Enjoy on-snow activities at Adventure Kingdom!

One of the Tohoku region's largest ski areas, ALTS Bandai (in Bandai Town) offers "Adventure Kingdom" right in front of the slopes, with all sorts of on-snow attractions. In the center is the "Pao Village" (pao = nomadic people's house). There is a "pao" where you can enjoy apple bake and hot chocolate while another offers you the hands-on experience of meat smoking. Attractions at the Adventure Kingdom include a snowmobile tour, banana-boat, snow train, a sledding area, "kamakura" snow hut area, and leading a horse — a plethora of family pleasures.
